

5150 COVER SHEET – ACC CRMC

1) Primary care team → Assemble 5150 team

- Assign a staff member to stay with patient at all times
- Call CRMC security (56574 or 56575) and let them know we are placing a 5150
- Page Psychiatry (559-487-4211) - if no answer call Dr. H (cell # posted in resident workroom)
NOTE: if the patient is actively harming himself or others call 9-1-1 from an ACC phone

2) Mental health team → Prepare 5150 packet

- Fill out all 13 sections of 5150 – double check using “cheat sheet” if needed (ATTACHED)
NOTE: for minors write parents’ names and phone numbers as well
NOTE: only someone trained and certified by the county can fill out a 5150
- Copy and have staff – 1) fax 5150 to 455-4633 to “QI review” then – 2) scan into record
- Send original with the transport team still attached to this sheet
- Fill out the ACC medical clearance form – with help from provider as needed (ATTACHED)
- Complete, print, and attach your note – either use Dr. Hersevoort’s smartphrase .IMHSUICIDE or write your own note including vital and problem list (.vitals and .prob)
- Call EXODUS as a courtesy – Adult (453-1008) or child (600-6760) to let them know that the ACC is sending a patient on a 5150 by CRMC security car – If they are unfamiliar with this process, let the know that we are an outpatient clinic and not the CRMC emergency department and therefore do not need an approval – SEE NOTE TO EXODUS STAFF BELOW

3) Primary care team → Arrange transport

If medically cleared

- Have CRMC security transport patient to Exodus Adult or Exodus Child services directly

If NOT medically cleared

- Call American Ambulance to have an adult taken to ED of choice, or child to CRMC ED

NOTE TO EXODUS STAFF: The ACC (Ambulatory Care Center) is an outpatient training clinic and has no regular inpatient, emergency, or security services available. If for any reason you are not able to care for a patient we have sent to you, please transport them to the CRMC Emergency Department and not back to the ACC clinic.
